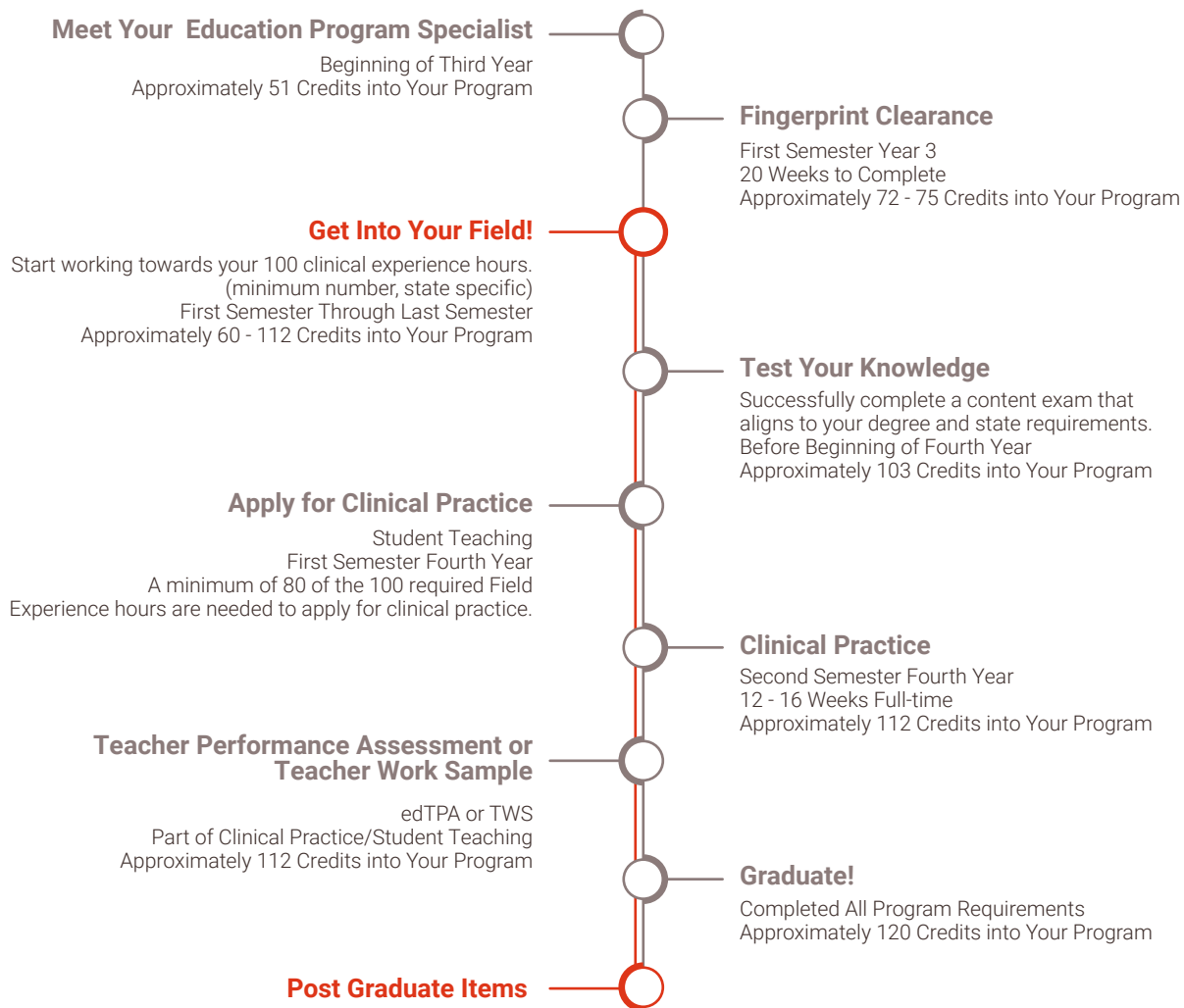


FOR STATE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS, CLICK ON THE "STATE

STUDENT TEACHING AND PLACEMENT SUPPORT ROLES:

Progression Specialist – Supports students with a full understanding of program requirements such as, fingerprinting, observation hours, documentation for student teaching, and testing.

Placement Specialist – Communicates with students and school districts to support students with placement for program requirements.

Cooperating Teacher – Supervises the student on site within classroom. Monitors progress and provides feedback and grades.

Faculty Supervisor – The Faculty Supervisor serves as a liaison between the teacher candidate, UOPX, and cooperating teacher and provides guidance and feedback during the student teaching experience.

PROGRAM ADVISEMENT ROLES:

Enrollment Representative – Supports students decision in choosing a specific program to start at the University. Assists in ensuring the student has full knowledge of a program prior to starting.

Academic Counselor – Coaches student through program. Assists student in understanding all program requirements during the duration of the program.

Faculty – Facilitates classroom objectives to meet program student learning outcomes.
